Each year an allocation is provided to youth theatre members by the committee under its scheme of assistance for subscription fees by needy students. The year is divided into two terms, one commencing in January, and the other commencing in September. There is an equal fee of &85 for both terms. The County Limerick Youth Theatre is a not-for-profit organisation and all members are required to assist with fundraising initiatives. Bursaries must be applied for EACH term. The committee does not have the facilities to accommodate long-term bursaries except under exceptional circumstances.

The grant allocation for a term is based on information about the number of needy students requesting assistance in that term.

The amount of assistance to individual students may be fixed at the discretion of the committee having regard to the total and relative levels of need and available resources.

The scheme only applies to "needy students" in the County Limerick Youth Theatre
